Distinguished by its graphic simplicity and contrasting natural materials, the JWDA Lamp Collection for MENU is both raw and refined. Designed by Jonas Wagell and inspired by traditional oil lamps, the elliptical opal glass shade and rounded metal base of his lamp, floor and table designs create simplified shapes that are timeless additions to modern spaces. The collection celebrates its perfect marriage of materials and ambience with two new colours: Ammonite Grey and Alabaster White express a newfound warmth and friendliness to brighten every room as well as every mood.

#### About The Designer

Jonas Wagell is a Swedish architect and designer born in 1973. Wagell is widely revered for his modern product and furniture design comprising soft, minimalist shapes with a welcoming expression.

Studio JWDA was founded in 2008 and is located in the Old Town of Stockholm, whilst recent clients and collaborative relations that stretch from Scandinavia to China, Italy and North America. Today the work is primarily focused on product and furniture design, but occasionally the studio also consults with art and design direction. The studio's architecture work is perhaps most known for the prefab house concept Mini House, early recognized by Wallpaper\* Magazine which named Wagell one of the "world's 50 hottest young architects" in 2008.
