Inspired by the old shaker tradition Nestor is designed by Danish architect Tom Stepp. 'Nestor' means *'the noblest and - implicitly the wisest'* and exemplifies how genuine materials and detail to comfort creates great design. The chair is designed with careful attentions to detail making it an exceptionally comfortable and a long-lasting piece of furniture, shaped to fit the human body. The wide armrest matches the backrest and creates a large surface to rest the arm, which increases comfort.

The wood is sustainably sourced from well-managed forests and thereby honoring the UN Sustainable Development Goals of protecting "Life on Land" (SDGs 15) and "Responsible Consumption and Production" (SDGs 12) and supporting "Partnership for the Goals" (SDGs 17).

*All waste wood from this design is converted into wood pellets, used to make the factory self-sufficient in supply of heating.*
