### **Cast Bronze Tumbled and Aged Finishes**

Bronze Tumbled and Aged finishes are an individually applied effect, and subtle variations occur during the process of application. The texture, darkness and colour hue will differ very slightly between each product.

Our bespoke bronze finishes are coated with a layer of clear-coat protection. Longevity is not guaranteed for a fixed time period or for all environments; this will vary depending on location, site conditions, cleaning, exposure to caustic substances etc. To refurbish/refresh the clear protection coating, the product needs to be returned to Rakumba. We therefore recommend treating the surface with care to preserve it as long as possible.

### **Installation Care (Cast Bronze Tumbled and Aged Finishes)**

1. Please always use the white cotton gloves provided to gently handle the light during installation.
  2. Clear-coat finishes may accumulate fingerprints when touched. Avoid direct contact during installation.

### **Maintenance Care (Cast Bronze Tumbled and Aged Finishes)**

1. Clear-coat finishes may accumulate fingerprints when touched. Avoid direct contact during maintenance.
2. The surface will easily clean up with a lightly damp cloth. Do not use solvent based or abrasive cleaners.
3. Remove the diffuser using white cotton gloves and avoid direct contact with the lightsource during maintenance.
4. If at any point the clear-coat deteriorates beyond your maintenance capabilities, return the product to Rakumba.

### **Cast Aluminium Tumbled Finishes**

Aluminium tumbled finishes are an individually applied effect, and subtle variations occur during the process of application. The texture, darkness and colour hue will differ very slightly between each product.

Unless specified, our bespoke aluminium finishes are provided without a layer of clear-coat protection. These natural finishes are “aging” or “living” finishes. Tumbled aluminium will oxidise and age, giving your light an individual character over time. The degree of aging will vary depending on the environment and element exposure, altering the visual appearance of your sconce through time and use.

If your fitting was specified with a clear coat protection, please refer to the care instructions information provided for the Cast Bronze Tumbled and Aged Finishes.

### **Installation Care (Cast Aluminium Tumbled Finishes)**

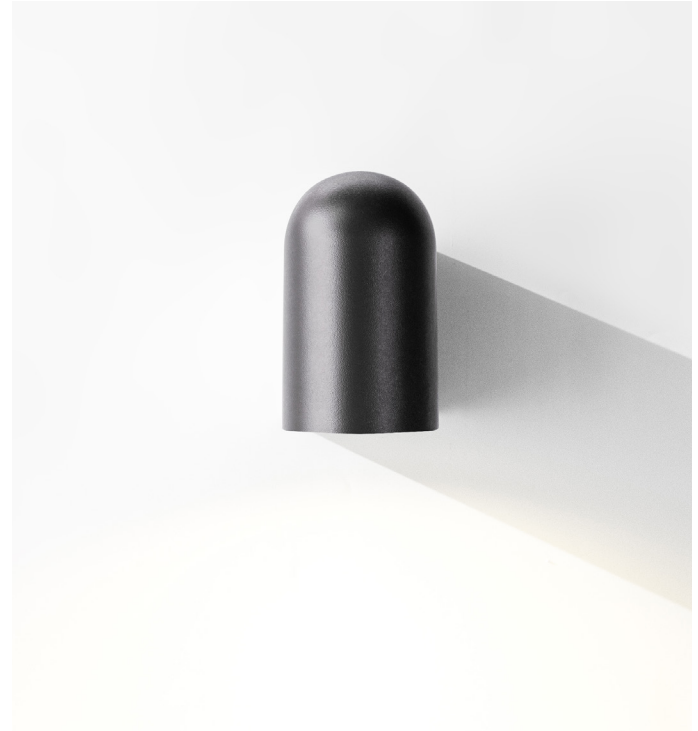
1. Please always use the white cotton gloves provided to gently handle the light during installation.
  2. Aluminium tumbled finishes will oxidise from the oils on our fingers. Avoid direct contact during installation.

### **Maintenance Care (Cast Aluminium Tumbled Finishes)**

1. Aluminium tumbled finishes will oxidise from the oils on our fingers. Avoid direct contact during maintenance.
2. Gently remove dust with a clean, dry cloth. Do not use solvent based or abrasive cleaners.

### **Textured Powdercoat Finishes**

Powdercoated surface options are durable and easy to clean finishes. Avoid touching with bare hands to prevent fingerprints from accumulating, but should these occur, they are easy to clean off following the maintenance routine below. Powder-coat is an impermeable finish and will not change over time. Take care not to clean it with abrasive compounds, as scratches can not be removed.

### **Installation Care (Powdercoat Finishes)**

1. Please always use the white cotton gloves provided to gently handle the light during installation.
  2. Powdercoat finishes may accumulate fingerprints when touched. Avoid direct contact during installation.

### **Maintenance Care (Powdercoat Finishes)**

1. Powdercoat finishes may accumulate fingerprints when touched. Avoid direct contact during maintenance.
2. To remove fingerprints from the powdercoated finishes, use a non-abrasive window cleaner sprayed onto a soft cloth. Never spray liquid cleaners directly onto the light fitting. For particularly stubborn marks, methylated spirits may be used.
3. Remove the diffuser using white cotton gloves and avoid direct contact with the lightsource during maintenance.
